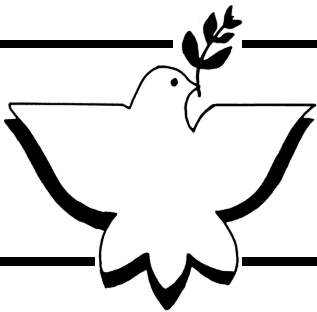

### Joseph Cirincione

is a national security security analyst and author. He served as the president of the Ploughshares Fund, a public grant-making foundation focused on nuclear nonproliferation and conflict resolution. He is an adjunct faculty member at the Georgetown University School of Foreign Service.

Cirincione previously served as vice president for national security and international policy at the Center for American Progress. For eight years, he was the director for non-proliferation at the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace, where he chaired and organized five annual Carnegie International Non-Proliferation Conferences. He worked for nine years in the US House of Representatives as a professional staff member of the Committee on Armed Services.
