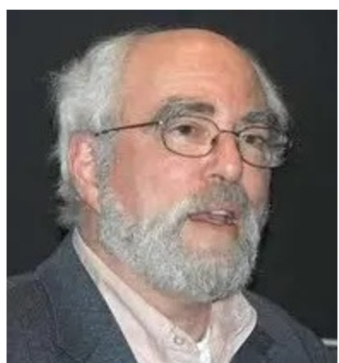

Alexandra Bell

is President & CEO of the Bulletin of Atomic Scientists. Before joining the Bulletin, Bell served as Deputy Assistant Secretary for Nuclear Affairs in the Bureau of Arms Control, Deterrence, and Stability (ADS) at the US Department of State. There she managed the Offices of Strategic Stability and Deterrence and Multilateral and Nuclear Affairs. From 2017 to 2021, Bell was the Senior Policy Director at the Center for Arms Control and Non-Proliferation and the Council for a Livable World.



Dr. Joseph Gerson is President of the Campaign for Peace, Disarmament and Common Security (CPDCS), Co-chair of the Committee for a Sane U.S.-China Policy and Co-Convener of the International Peace and Planet Network. He educates and organizes at local, national, and international levels for peaceful and just alternatives to US foreign and military policies, concentrating on great power tensions, nuclear dangers and disarmament, working closely with Asian and European peace movements and advocates.
